## BlueTooth Hearing-Aids for Hams

Hearing devices that can be controlled by smart-phones to adjust volume, tone, and programs as well as direct streaming audio from various devices have recently become available from several manufacturers. The following is a list of the ones that I've found. This category of BlueTooth technology is probably not compatible with that generated by new Ham Rigs so they cannot stream the rig audio directly, but there are options.

The remote microphone and/or the TV and music sending device holds promise for Ham use but many of the seller don't even mention the capability when fitting new devices.
